## Lodging

The Foster Retreat Center has 3 Family Rooms for those with small children (call Karen for details). Remainder of rooms are bunkhouse style (5-8 twin beds per room, no bunk beds) segregated into male rooms and female rooms. Bunkhouse Pricing is Per Bed \$42 (covers 2 nights). Family Rooms are \$127-169/room (covers 2 nights). A total of 40 beds are available. Please reserve your bed(s) by 3/15/18.

There are four bathrooms at the center. The women's side is a continuously connected set of rooms with its own shared bathroom within. The men's side and family rooms have access to the other three bathrooms.

For most situations, staying at the retreat center will be significantly more cost effective than staying at one of the local hotels, and will provide greater fellowship opportunities.
